

Using Masonry Saw Bench

- Protective equipment must be worn including ear defenders, dust mask and goggles 1.
- 2. Switch off and wait for the machine to stop completely before making adjustments or fitting or changing the wheel
- 3. Check that the cutting wheel is fitted correctly and that the guard is properly adjusted.
- If using water as a coolant or lubricant, check it is flowing correctly. 4.
- 5. Make sure that the saw is running at full speed before starting to cut.
- 6. Be prepared for the reactive force when the wheel contacts the surface to be cut.
- If the saw starts to labour and slow down, do not force it so hard. Do not overload the saw. 7. Keeping the wheel speed p is more effective than aggressive pressure
- 8.
- The machine can only cut in straight lines. It should not be used to cut round corners. 9.
- 10. Stop the saw if someone approaches the work area.
- 11. Switch off and unplug before leaving the masonry saw bench unattended.
- 12. If the equipment does not work properly, do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
