

Using the Floodlight

- Propane gas is highly flammable and must always be used with great care. Cylinders must not be stored in occupied domestic premises.
- This floodlight is designed to provide general illumination in remote outdoor locations, on site, and in other well ventilated locations.
- The floodlight must not be used where there is a fire risk from combustible materials, or flammable liquids and gases. Make sure there is no paper or other light, flammable materials that could be carried towards the floodlight by air flow.
- Heated air and direct radiant heat from the floodlight can damage nearby objects as well as presenting a fire risk. Make sure that there are no objects near enough to the floodlight to get hot.
- Plan the use of the floodlight so that it can always be used safely. It should not be left unattended if there is any risk of fire or burns to persons.
- This floodlight must not be lit, moved, or adjusted, and the gas cylinder must not be changed, by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- This floodlight is designed for operation by an able bodied adult. Anyone with either a temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it.


